Comm. 10am. Entry fee £15.00 per class . Rosettes to 6th Place. Prizes in all classes to 1st place . All entries must be made prior to the day online @ www.sunnybankec.com just click on the event date and the entry form and schedule is there. Entries close on 23rd December. Times will be out on the 24th December after 6pm.

Don't forget to wear your Christmas Jumpers.

Class 1. Little elf mini stakes. Fences not to exceed 30cms. Competitors can be on a lead rein. -X Poles

Class 2. Pine needle stakes .fences will not exceed 40cms. Competitors can be on a lead rein -X Poles

Class 3. Xmas Pudding stakes fences not to exceed 0.50cms. Competitors can be on a lead rein -X Poles

Class 4. Ginger Bread Man stakes fences not to exceed 55cms.

Class 5. Candy Cane stakes fences not to exceed 60cms

Class 6. Christmas Card Stakes fences not to exceed 65cms

Class 7. Xmas Cracker fences not to exceed 0.70cms

Class 8. Snowman stakes fences not to exceed 0.75cms .

Class 9. Xmas Turkey Stakes . Fences not to exceed 0.80cms.

Class 10. Xmas tree stakes fences not to exceed 0.85cms

Class 11. Mince Pie stakes fences not to exceed 0.90cms.

Class 12. The reindeer puissance (this will be split horses & Ponies for prizes & rosettes)

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Current British Standard Headgear must be worn at all times when mounted. It is strongly recommended that all riders wear back protectors whilst jumping. Skull caps or hats with a 3 point harness correctly fastened are mandatory for any show jumping competition. Must be up to the current standard.*
- 2. The judges decision is final .*
- 3. To enter this show you need not be a member, but qualification will only be given to those who fulfil the relevant criteria as per the society rules for the regional finals where appropriate.*
- 4. Entry fees are not refundable – if the event is postponed all entries will be carried forward to the next show within 6 months.*
- 5. There are no dogs allowed on the show ground except for guide dogs.***
- 6. It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors carry adequate Public Liability Insurance. Sunnybank EC its employees or assistants do not accept any liability for any injury or damage sustained by any third party whether to horse/rider spectator or property whatsoever and how so ever caused.*
- 7. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without any reason being given and if necessary to alter or cancel any class at anytime.*
- 8. Any vehicles parked do so at their own risk.*
- 9. All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over to compete in ridden classes.*
- 10. Jump bats only are allowed no ordinary whips in show jumping competitions.*
- 11. Any objections must be received in writing within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the class together with a deposit of £30 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.*
- 12. No lungeing working in or cantering is allowed in the lorry park no dung to be left in carpark. Anyone found skipping out lorries/trailers in the carpark putting manure in the bins or leaving it on the show ground will be banned.*
- 13. Sunnybank EC has animals and children present. We must insist on a strict 5mph speed limit.***
- 14. All children attending Sunnybank EC must be supervised by a responsible adult. SBEC Rules apply to this qualifier*

15. Anyone found skipping out their lorries/trailers in the car park, or dumping manure in the bins will be fined and banned. Take your manure home.

16. strictly no Dogs allowed on the show ground except guide dogs.

17. There is a maximum weight limit of riders to horses based on 20% of the horse/ponies body weight. Please remember this includes the saddle bridle and rider. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone who appears to exceed this.

18.you can compete in a maximum of 4 classes per horse/pony.

19.Anyone found bringing a horse or pony to Sunnybank which has knowingly been in contact with any infectious or contagious diseases or have known diseases will be asked to leave and banned for life.

20.All horses/ponies attending our events must be fully vaccinated . Copies of name page and vaccination page must be submitted to sunnybank via whatsapp with entries to 07767374079

Sunnybank EC it's employees officials stewards or anyone volunteering shall in any way be liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss or for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to Exhibitors, Competitors, or members of the General Public or their Servants, Agents or to anyone on the Showground, or for any loss, claim, matter circumstance or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of nor attributable or any journey to or from the Show.

- No individual for which he/she is responsible as owner lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure that other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry; cancel or alter classes or postpone the event due to unforeseen circumstances. The organisers also reserve the right, if necessary, to amend the schedule, which may mean that riders compete in less classes than advertised. In the unlikely event that the event is cancelled & we are unable to transfer the event to another day , the Organisers will return everyone's monies, less an administration charge of up to 50% of the total price, to cover the irrecoverable costs of preparing to host the event.

Whilst at our events DO NOT-

1. DO NOT Let your horse graze
2. DO NOT Let them touch any other horses or stand too close to other horses
3. DO NOT Leave them tied to the trailer or lorry
4. DO NOT Let strangers touch your horses.
5. DO NOT Let them eat a haynet outside the lorry or trailer
6. DO NOT go anywhere other than permitted areas.
7. DO NOT Hang around the arena or collecting rings once you have competed.

All of the above must be complied with and are a condition of entering our events. It is up to each and everyone of you to be vigilant, stay away from other horses- do not share water and take responsibility for keeping your horses safe.
