There are strictly no dogs allowed on the show ground All horses must have up to date vaccinations & passports maybe checked.

Class 1.Teams. Fences not to exceed 0.30cms competitors may be on a lead rein. Team may consist of juniors and seniors mixed. The fences will be X poles Entry Fee £60

Class 1A Individuals Fences not to exceed 0.30 cms competitors may be on a Lead rein . Entry fee £15

Class 2.Teams. Fences not to exceed 0.40cms competitors may be on a lead rein. Team may consist of juniors and seniors mixed. The fences will be X poles Entry Fee £60

Class 2A Individuals Fences not to exceed 0.40 cms competitors may be on a Lead rein . Entry fee £15

Class 3.Teams. Fences not to exceed 0.50cms competitors may be on a lead rein. Team may consist of juniors and seniors mixed. The fences will be X poles Entry Fee £60

Class 3A Individuals Fences not to exceed 0.50cms competitors may be on a Lead rein . Entry fee £15

Class 4. Teams. Fences not to exceed 0.55cms competitors may be on a lead rein. Team may consist of juniors and seniors mixed.

Class 5. Teams. Fences not to exceed 0.60cms. Team may consist of juniors and seniors mixed. Entry Fee £60

Class 5A Individuals Fences not to exceed 0.60cms Entry fee £15

Class 6. Teams. Fences not to exceed 0.65cms in the first round. Teams may consist of juniors and seniors mixed.

Entry Fee £60

Class 6A Individuals Fences not to exceed 0.65cms in the first round. Entry fee £15

Class 7. Individual Fences not to exceed 70cms in the first round. Entry fee £15

Class 8. Intermediate Teams. Fences not to exceed 0.75cms in the first round.

Teams may consist of juniors and seniors mixed.

Entry Fee £60

Class 8A Individuals Fences not to exceed 0.75cms in the first round Entry fee £15

Class 9. Open Teams. Fences not to exceed 0.80cms in the first round. Teams may consist of juniors and seniors mixed.

Entry Fee £60

Class 9A Individuals Fences not to exceed 0.80cms in the first round. Entry fee £15

Class 10. Individuals Fences not to exceed 85cms in the first round. Entry fee £15.

Class 11. Advanced Teams. Fences not to exceed 0.90 in the first round.

Teams may consist of juniors and seniors mixed.

Entry Fee £60

Class 11a Individuals Fences not to exceed 0.90cms in the first round. Entry fee £15

Class 12. Individuals Fences not to exceed 1.00m in the first round. Entry fee £15.

The rules are as follows.

All 4 members of the team will jump one after each other the competition will run as Single phase competition. All competitors unless eliminated in phase 1 will jump into phase 2 which is against the clock.

All second rounds will be timed and the winners of each competition determined from the 2nd round.

Three scores from each team will count, there by dropping the highest faults.

It is possible to compete with 3 in the team, but all 3 scores will be carried forward.

If 2 members of the team are eliminated in the 1st phase then the team is eliminated.

If 2 members are eliminated in the 2^{nd} round then the team is eliminated. Rosettes to 4^{th} place..

Teams are competing for Challenge trophies at the end of the series. Points will be allocated at every team event and the winners at the end of the series will receive Challenge Shields and sashes.

The large shields will remain at Sunnybank with the team names on. Smaller replicas will be given to each team member to keep.

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Current British Standard Headgear must be worn at all times when mounted. It is strongly recommended that all riders wear back protectors whilst jumping. Skull caps or hats with a 3 point harness correctly fastened are mandatory for any show jumping competition. It is strongly advised that body protectors are worn.
- 2. The judges decision is final.
- 3. Only BS Standard Jump bats are allowed. No ordinary whips.
- 4.. Entry fees are not refundable.
- 5. There are no dogs allowed on the show ground except for guide dogs.
- 6. It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors carry adequate Public Liability Insurance. Sunnybank EC its employees or assistants do not accept any liability for any injury or damage sustained by any third party whether to horse/rider spectator or property whatsoever and how so ever caused.
- 7. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without any reason being given and if necessary to alter or cancel any class at anytime.
- 8. Any vehicles parked do so at their own risk.
- 9.All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over to compete in classes.
- If a team competes in the 0.50 class they cannot jump in the 0.75 class. Max 3 classes per team or horse.
- 10. Outside assistance is forbidden unless there is a fall of horse/rider.
- 11. Any objections must be received in writing within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the class together with a deposit of £30 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 12. No lungeing working in or cantering is allowed in the lorry park.
- 13. No dung or bedding is to be left in the car park.
- 16. The show employs stewards to ensure the safe running of the show. Their advice should be followed at all times.
- 17. In the event of a fall the rider must leave the course..
- 18. No timing devices of any type are to be worn
- 19. The organisers have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. In order for those measures to be effective, everyone must take care to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions of the stewards at all times.
- 20. Anyone found bringing a horse or pony to Sunnybank which has knowingly been in contact with any infectious or contagious diseases or have known diseases will be asked to leave and banned for life.

Sunnybank EC it's employees officials stewards or anyone volunteering shall in any way be liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss or for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to Exhibitors, Competitors, or members of the General Public or their Servants, Agents or to anyone on the Showground, or for any loss, claim, matter circumstance or event

whatsoever in connection with or arising out of nor attributable or any journey to or from the Show.

• No individual for which he/she is responsible as owner lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure that other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.

• The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry; cancel or alter classes or postpone the event due to unforeseen circumstances. The organisers also reserve the right, if necessary, to amend the schedule, which may mean that riders compete in less classes than advertised. In the unlikely event that the event is cancelled & we are unable to transfer the event to another day, the Organisers will return everyone's monies, less an administration charge of up to 50% of the total price, to cover the irrecoverable costs of preparing to host the event.

Whilst at our events DO NOT-

- 1. DO NOT Let your horse graze
- 2. DO NOT Let them touch any other horses or stand too close to other horses
- 3. DO NOT Leave them tied to the trailer or lorry
- 4. DO NOT Let strangers touch your horses.
- 5. DO NOT Let them eat a haynet outside the lorry or trailer
- 6. DO NOT go anywhere other than permitted areas.
- 7. DO NOT Hang around the arena or collecting rings once you have competed.

All of the above must be complied with and are a condition of entering our events. It is up to each and everyone of you to be vigilant, stay away from other horses- do not share water and take responsibility for keeping your horses safe.
