Class 20. Best pure or Part Bred Arab

Class 21. Coloured horse. Horse to exceed 14.2hh, rider any age. Rider must be the right size for the horse.

Class 22. Best riding club/all round horse to exceed 14.2hh

First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final: VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2024 Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. *This MUST be done within 21 days of qualification*. It is the competitors responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge. Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK Lincolnshire on 30th Aug -1st September 2024. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid-season 2023.

- CLASS 23 **VETERAN IN-HAND, COMBINED AGE CLASS** (15 years and over). To be run as one class but judged as separate age categories: Diamond Veteran (25 years and over), Veteran (20–24 years) & Pre-Veteran (15–19 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height.
- CLASS 24 **VETERAN RIDDEN, COMBINED AGE CLASS** (15 years and over). To be run as one class but judged as separate age categories: Diamond Veteran (25 years and over), Veteran (20–24 years) & Pre-Veteran (15–19 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height.

Championship for 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes 18-24 Supreme champion and reserve of show open to champions and Reserve Champions. This will be held in Ring 1. (3)

Class 25. Best turned out horse/pony rider any age .Class will be split horse & pony if sufficient entries.

Class 26. Best lead rein pony, not to exc 12.2hh any breed or type rider not to have attained their 12th birthday by 1st Jan of the current year.

Class 27 Best first ridden pony not to exc 13hh rider not to have attained their 12th birthday by 1 Jan in the current year.

Class 28 Best show pony not to exc 14.2hh rider any age but must be the correct size for the pony.

Class 29. Best pony not exc 14.2hh. Any type of pony may enter this class. Rider any age but must be the correct size for the pony.

Class 30. Best Show Hunter Pony, not to exceed 15hh rider any age but must be the correct size for the pony.

Class 31. Horse/Pony & rider not to have won a 1st rosette prior to todays show in a showing class.

Class 32. Best Horse or Pony any type any breed.

Championship for 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes 26-32 Supreme champion and reserve of show open to champions and Reserve Champions. This will be held in Ring 1. (4)

Class 42. Small breeds Mountain & Moorland registered or unregistered, rider any age but must be the correct size for the pony.

Class 43. Best Welsh Part Bred. Rider any age

Class 44. Best all round pony.

Championship for 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 37-38 40-44 Supreme champion and reserve of show open to champions and Reserve Champions. This will be held in Ring 1. (5) Supreme to be judged by Julie Crowley & Karen Morgan

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Correct British Standard Headgear up to the latest standard must be worn at all times when mounted with a three point harness.. Handlers under 14 years must wear correctly secured BSI Skull cap/Riding hats.
- 2. The judges decision is final.
- 3. To enter this show you need not be a member, but qualification will only be given to those who fulfil the relevant criteria as per the society rules for the regional finals where appropriate.
- 4. Entry fees are not refundable.
- 5. There are strictly no dogs allowed on the show ground except for assisted dogs
- 6. It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors carry adequate Public Liability Insurance.

 Sunnybank EC its employees or assistants do not accept any liability for any injury or damage sustained by any third party whether to horse/rider spectator or property whatsoever and how so ever caused.
- 7. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without any reason being given and if necessary to alter or cancel any class at anytime.
- 8. Any vehicles parked do so at their own risk.
- 9. Spurs/Dress spurs may not be worn in any show hunter pony/intermediate show hunter or any ridden Mountain& Moorland class. Competition Horse/Pony, Riding Horse and competitors in Sports horse classes may wear spurs.
- 10. Any pony stallion not exceeding 138cms Or Small breeds M&M stallion may not be ridden by juniors who have not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Stallions exceeding 138cms or Large Breed M&M may not be ridden by juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
- 11. Show canes whips are not allowed to exceed 30" (75cms). In lead rein classes plain or leather covered canes only maybe used. Spurs may not be worn in Riding pony, WHP, SHP or Mountain & Moorland classes.
- 12. Any objections must be received in writing within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the class together with a deposit of £30 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 13. No working in or cantering is allowed in the lorry park.
- 14. No dung or bedding is to be left in the car park. Anyone found skipping out lorries/trailers in the car park, or putting it in the bins will be fined and banned.
- 15. Only food and drink purchased at Sunnybank ec can be taken into the indoor arena
- 16. No horse manure hay etc to be put in the bins provided. They are for litter only.
- 17. In the event of the show having to be cancelled prior to the day 50% of all entry fees will be retained for administration. In the unfortunate event of the show having to be abandoned on the day, no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. We have no facilities for you to lunge your horses/ponies. Lungeing is forbidden at all indoor shows in the manege or indoor arena.
- 19. Anyone found bringing a horse or pony to Sunnybank which has knowingly been in contact with any infectious or contagious diseases or have known diseases will be asked to leave and banned for life.
- 21. All horses/ponies competing at Sunnybank must have up to date Vaccinations. All passports must accompany the horse and maybe checked for validation.
