There will be 3 rings , the working hunter ring will be outdoors. There will also be an outdoor area for warm up. The In-hand classes will take place in the menage and the ridden classes in the whole of the indoor arena. The arena will not be split this year. **Entries are capped at 10 per class (except workers) so you will need to get your entries in please**

Sponsors will be selecting people for spot prizes sashes Goodie bags and awards throughout the day.

All entries to be made via www.sunnybankec.com just click on events then the date and its all there.

Admission Charges: All non-towing vehicles will be charged admission of £5 per vehicle. There will be no exceptions. Non-towing vehicles must park in the area allocated. No non-towing vehicles will be allowed in the lorry park.

Entry fees are £20 per class except Novelty which are £8.

There are strictly no dogs allowed on the show ground other than guide dogs/Certified assistance dogs. We strongly advise you not to bring dogs at all as you will not be admitted with a dog in the car or lorry. No skipping out of lorries or trailers on the show ground is permitted.

Rosettes will be presented during the daytime classes. All Championships will be judged in evening performance. Championship is for 1st & 2nd prize winners from daytime classes.

There will be random qualifiers given through the day that will be going through to special championships.

Afternoon /Evening performances times will be announced after close of entries. The order of classes for the evening will be displayed during the show and put on the web site www.sunnybankec.com closer to the date of show. Times will be allocated for Championships. Competitors will be called up to wait in the covered warm up arena in strict class order ready for the evening performance. Classes will be called in plenty of time for you to get ready.

The dress code for the evening is black or navy show jackets, cream or canary Jodhpurs or breeches and stocks. In hands. Smart evening wear please. With the exception of Novelty classes- unless they want to. Anyone under the age of 14 must wear an up to date BS riding hat to show.

All competitors that are riding must wear hard hats up to the current British standard with a three-point harness. Top hats can only be worn if a disclaimer is signed and handed to the secretary on the day.

There will be a championship for each section. The champion and reserve in Championships 7 – 16 will receive a sash and lovely rosettes. Challenge cups will also be awarded to each Champion and Prize money of £40. Reserves £20. Other Championships will receive different award. The wild card Champion & Young Handler will receive £20 and Reserve £10. Novelty Champion & Reserve will receive sashes. The Pony Club Championship sash will be awarded to the person that members of Sunnybank Pony club select ,The Best rider , Sponsors Choice & Golden Oldie will receive a sash & lovely rosette & other prizes. Cards for the sponsors choice Champion will be handed out throughout the day along with Wild Card Championship & sponsors choice. Plus random awards and prizes. There will be a special award DAVID PESCI MEMORIAL SASH. The winner will be selected from Champions and Reserves that are eligible for the Supreme

of show. They will receive £50. Mrs Julie Pesci will select the Winner
There will also be a supreme and reserve supreme & 1st reserve supreme of show. Which will take place at the end of the evening. This will be open to the Champions and Reserves from each section. There will also be spot prizes and awards throughout the day.
Supreme of show will receive £150 plus a challenge cup Reserve Supreme £100 and 1st reserve £60. You will also receive beautiful sashes.
All prizes must be collected on show day.
There will be prize money of £10 to those placed 1st in all classes **except Novelty classes** providing there are 3 or more entries.
Entry fees for all classes £20 except Novelty which are £8 per class.
Supreme of show is open to Champions & Reserves from Championships 7-16 only - Novelty, Young Handler, Pony club, Best Rider, Golden Oldie, Sponsors choice Champions or random Champions are NOT eligible for Supreme of Show.

Please remember that entries close on 20/09/26, there will be no exceptions.
Entry fee per class are £20.00 per class except for novelty which is £8 per class .
All riders/handlers must pay £5 first aid cover per rider/handler.
Admission Charges: All non-towing vehicles will be charged admission of £5 per vehicle. There will be no exceptions. Non towing vehicles must park in the area allocated. No non towing vehicles will be allowed in the lorry park.

Class 33. Mountain & Moorland open Lead Rein, Mares or Geldings 4 years old and over, not exc 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 34. Mountain & Moorland open First Ridden. Mares or Geldings, 4 years old and over, not exc 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridle permitted.

Class 45. Riding cob. /Maxi cob Horse to exceed 14.2hh. rider must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st Jan in the current year.

Class 46. Racehorse to riding horse. Horses must have trained at an approved Racing Yard and be entered under their Wetherby passport name.

Class 49. . Novice showing class open to any breed or type- Riders must be over 50 years old on the day of the show . **You will only be required to walk and trot- no cantering . This is for riders that are new to showing please-**

Class 50. Tiny tots to include lead rein and first ridden. Pony not exceeding 128cms rider not to have attained their 10th birthday by 1st Jan 2026 fences not to exceed 30cms.

Class 51. Cradle & Nursery Stakes. Ponies not to exceed 133cms riders not to have attained their 12th Birthday by 1st Jan 2026. Max height of fences 40cm

Class 52. WHP Training stakes Horses and Ponies to be 4 years old and over. Max height of fences 50cms. Rider any age.

Class 53. WHP Training stakes Horses and Ponies to be 4 years old and over. Max height of fences 60cms. Rider any age.

Class 54. WHP Training stakes Horses and Ponies to be 4 years old and over. Max height of fences 70cms. Rider any age.

Class 55. WHP Training stakes Horses and Ponies to be 4 years old and over. Max height of fences 80cms. Rider any age.

Class 56. WHP Training stakes Horses and Ponies to be 4 years old and over. Max height of fences 90cms. Rider any age.

These classes will be marked 60 points Jumping. 20 points Style & Manners whilst Jumping 20 points Show & manners. You will be required to do your show straight after you jump.

RULES REGULATIONS AND CONDITION OF ENTRY

1. All Ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years old and over.
2. In lead rein classes the lead must be attached to the nose band.
3. Correct British Standard Headgear must be worn at all times when mounted. Hats with a 3 point harness up to BI Standard are compulsory while mounted. Handlers under 14 years must wear correctly secured BSI Skull cap/Riding hats.
4. The judge's decision is final.
5. To enter this show you need not be a member of any society
6. Entry fees are not refundable even with a vet's certificate.
7. In the event of the show having to be cancelled prior to the day ,50% of the entry fees will be retained for administration costs.
8. If the show has to be abandoned for any reason after it has started, no entry fees will be refunded.
9. There are no dogs allowed on the show ground. Except guide dogs or service dogs
10. It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors carry adequate Public Liability Insurance. Sunnybank EC its employees or assistants do not accept any liability for any injury or damage sustained by any third party whether to horse/rider spectator or property whatsoever and how so ever caused.
11. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without any reason being given and if necessary to alter or cancel any class at anytime.
12. Any vehicles parked do so at their own risk.
13. Any pony stallion not exceeding 138cms may not be ridden by juniors who have not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Stallions exceeding 138cms may not be ridden by juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
14. Show canes whips are not allowed to exceed 30" (75cms). In lead rein classes, plain or leather covered canes only maybe used. The only exception are Side Saddle classes.

15. There are no objections available at this show .
16. There is to be no skipping out of lorries or trailers on the show ground. No manure is to be placed in the bins. Please take it all home with you. Anyone found breaking the rule will be asked to leave the show ring.
17. It is the responsibility of all competitors, exhibitors and owners to read the above rules. When signing the entry forms, you agree to abide by them.
18. **Strictly no dogs allowed on the show ground. Anyone bringing dogs in hot weather to leave in their cars or lorries will be asked to vacate the show ground.**
19. Anyone found bringing a horse or pony to Sunnybank which has knowingly been in contact with any infectious or contagious diseases or have known diseases will be asked to leave and banned for life.
20. All horses must have up to date Flu vaccinations and spot checks of passports will be made . Anyone found to have NO passport or Flu Vaccinations that are not up to date will not be allowed entry. It is a condition of entry that passport details are submitted to sunnybank via whatsapp with your entry.
21. There will be a water trough for the horses and a tap to get water from by the trough.
22. All horses attending our shows must be free from disease. Anyone knowingly bringing a horse to Sunnybank that is contagious or infectious or has been in contact with a horse that is will receive a life time ban.
23. There is a strict 5mph speed limit please.
24. All prizes and prize money must be collected on the day.
25. The judges decision is final.
26. You must park where the stewards tell you please. Abuse of any kind towards stewards judges staff will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the showground.
27. **Classes will not be held for competitors.**
 Sunnybank EC it's employees officials stewards or anyone volunteering shall in any way be liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss or for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to Exhibitors, Competitors, or members of the General Public or their Servants, Agents or to anyone on the Showground, or for any loss, claim, matter circumstance or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of nor attributable to any journey to or from the Show.
 • No individual for which he/she is responsible as owner lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure that other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
 • The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry; cancel or alter classes or postpone the event due to unforeseen circumstances. The organisers also reserve the right, if necessary, to amend the schedule, which may mean that riders compete in less classes than advertised. In the unlikely event that the event is cancelled & we are unable to transfer the event to another day , the Organisers will return everyone's monies, less an administration charge of up to 50% of the total price, to cover the irrecoverable costs of preparing to host the event.

Whilst at our events DO NOT-

1. DO NOT Let your horse graze
2. DO NOT Let them touch any other horses or stand too close to other horses
3. DO NOT Leave them tied to the trailer or lorry

4. DO NOT Let strangers touch your horses.
5. DO NOT Let them eat a haynet outside the lorry or trailer
6. DO NOT go anywhere other than permitted areas.
7. DO NOT Hang around the arena or collecting rings once you have competed.

All of the above must be complied with and are a condition of entering our events.
It is up to each and everyone of you to be vigilant, stay away from other horses- do not share water and take responsibility for keeping your horses safe.
